

DECISION

of Central Election Commission of the Republic of Azerbaijan on the cancel of the registration of the authorized representative of the Unity Party in the Elections to the Milli Majlis of the Republic of Azerbaijan on February 9, 2020

Regarding the Elections to the Milli Majlis of the Republic of Azerbaijan on February 9, 2020, the Unity Party appealed to the Central Election Commission on January 11, 2020 and requested to cancel the registration of Fakhraddin Zayidagha Kerimli, registered as an authorized representative of the political party by the Commission decision # 19/89, dated December 20, 2019.

Upon investigating the appeal within the timeframe and manner defined by law, the Central Election Commission determined that the registration of authorized representative of the Unity Party F.Z.Karimli shall be canceled and in accordance with the item # 3.3 of the "Instruction on status of authorized representatives of candidates, political parties, blocs of political parties and referendum campaign groups in elections (referendum) of the Republic of Azerbaijan", the badge provided to him by the Central Election Commission shall be considered invalid.

By assuming the above-mentioned as a basis and pursuant to Articles 19.4, 19.14, 22, 28.2, 28.4 and 52.5 of Election Code of the Republic of Azerbaijan, CEC decides:

1. The registration of Fakhraddin Zayidagha Kerimli, authorized representative of the Unity Party in the Elections to the Milli Majlis of the Republic of Azerbaijan on February 9, 2020 shall be cancelled and the badge provided to him by the Central Election Commission shall be considered invalid.
2. The decision shall be enforced upon its publication
