

DECISION

OF THE CENTRAL ELECTION COMMISSION OF THE REPUBLIC OF AZERBAIJAN ON THE APPROVAL OF “REGULATION FOR THE WORKING GROUP ESTABLISHED FOR CHECKING THE ACCURACY OF THE INFORMATION IN THE SIGNATURE SHEETS AND OTHER ELECTION DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED TO ELECTION COMMISSIONS”

For complying the structural elements of the “Regulation for the working group established for checking the accuracy of the information in the signature sheets and other election documents submitted to election commissions” approved by CEC decision # 6/23-2 dated 4 July 2008 with the Article 30 of the Constitutional Law of the Republic of Azerbaijan “On normative legal acts” and regulating the relations coordinated by this Instruction more completely, it shall be invalidated by approving new act on the same subject.

Furthermore, within its competence the Central Election Commission shall ensure the implementation of the activities implied by legislation on the official publication and enforcement of this Regulation.

Adopting the above-mentioned as a basis and in accordance with Articles 78.2, 78.3 of the Constitutional Law of the Republic of Azerbaijan and articles 19.4, 19.14, 28.2 and 28.4 of the Election Code of the Republic of Azerbaijan, the Central Election Commission (CEC) **decides:**

1. “Regulation for the working group established for checking the accuracy of the information in the signature sheets and other election documents submitted to election commissions” shall be approved (attached).

2. Since the enforcement of this Regulation, the “Regulation for the working group established for checking the accuracy of the information in the signature sheets and other election documents submitted to election commissions” approved by CEC decision # 6/23-2 dated 4 July 2008 shall be invalidated.

3. Within its competence, CEC shall ensure the implementation of the activities implied by legislation on the official publication and enforcement of the approved instruction.
